This book introduces math in a fun way. Use the activities listed below to build math skills using daily routines.

- Count it out. Include counting in all of your daily routines. Count spoons and bowls as you set the table for breakfast. Sort and count socks as you put away laundry. Count how many steps it takes you to go down a flight of stairs, or count canned goods as you get ready for dinner.
- Size it up. Look for opportunities during your day to match size to need. Let your child find the right-sized lid for the pot you are using or choose the best bag to carry toys to grandma's.
- Cook it. Cooking provides wonderful math opportunities. Invite your child to help you in the kitchen. Let your child measure flour, count eggs, and estimate what a half of a stick of butter looks like. Point out numbers as you use a measuring cup, oven, or microwave.

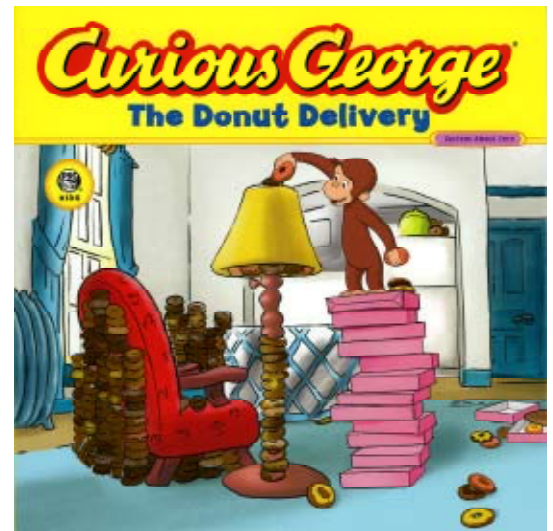
